







## PRIMARY SOURCE

"Shall New Jersey have the same right or influence in the councils of the nation as Pennsylvania? I say no. It is unjust. I will never confederate [join in] on this plan."

-James Wilson, Pennsylvania

## SECONDARY SOURCE

"Delegates from small states worried that the [Virginia Plan] would give large states control of Congress. With more votes, the larger states would be able to pass the laws they wanted. William Paterson offered a different plan, called the New Jersey Plan. Under this plan, the new Congress would have one house, in which each state would be equally represented. This plan would give the small states the same number of representatives as the large states."
